March 16, 1958 - October 27, 2019

Emile Jack Pourroy, Jr. passed away on Sunday, October 27, 2019 at the age of 61 after a courageous two-and-a-half-year battle with brain cancer.

Emile, also known as “Knuté” to his close friends and family, was born on March 16, 1958 to Patsy and Emile Pourroy, Sr. His childhood was enjoyed in sunny Santa Monica, CA where he spent summers swimming and enjoying the beach at Lifeguard Station 26.

At the young age of 19 he opted to invest his time learning a trade to support his family and became an electrician and member of the International Brotherhood of Electrical Workers (IBEW). He was co-owner of a successful electrical contracting business and worked in the industry for over 35 years.

Giving back to the community in which he lived and helping others was vitally important to him and gave him much satisfaction in life. He was a loving and devoted father to his four children and often spent his free time at their sporting and scouting events. For many years, Knuté volunteered for the Boy Scouts to spend quality time with his sons, Kevin and Ryan and to be a mentor for others. He also served as a facilitator for the Youth Confirmation program for his Catholic Parish as his children were completing the program.

Knuté had a strong passion for the mountains and hiking outdoors. He served as a volunteer reserve deputy for the Los Angeles County Sheriff’s department on the Santa Clarita Valley Search and Rescue Team for 27 years holding the important leadership positions of lieutenant and captain.

When confronted with his diagnosis, Knuté chose to face it head on, turning to his strong faith in God and the support of his family to lead him through his battle with cancer. He never complained and always made a point to be positive, often joking and laughing with his medical team with the goal of making everyone smile.

He is preceded in death by his parents Patsy and Emile Sr., and his son Ryan. He will be

sadly missed by his loving wife Suzanne; step-son Joseph and step-daughter Rebecca; his daughter Jacquelyn and son-in-law Matt; his daughter Andie and son-in-law Michael; his son Kevin, daughter-in-law Jamie and beautiful granddaughter Charlotte; his sister Debbie; his brother Gary and sister-in-law Beatriz; his sister Desiree and brother-in-law Amado; his sister Deanna and brother-in-law Robert; his in-laws (Jeff and Isabel, Cindy and Ron, Andrew, and Jennifer), uncles, numerous nieces, nephews, cousins, and extended family, and his four poodles—Soleil, Mozelle, Marcie and Ruby.
