May 20, 1929 - September 6, 2019

Harvey Morgan, a faithful Jehovah's Witness, fell asleep in death at his home on September 6, 2019 at the age of 90. Harvey was born in Scranton, PA on May 20, 1929 to the late Haydn and Zelpha Rose Morgan. In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by his sister, Brenda Notari; and brothers, Haydn, Elmer, Arthur, and Kent Morgan. He married Helena Marie Osborne, on November 22, 1951 and had three children. He moved to Deerfield Beach, FL in 1979 and later moved to Mooresville, NC in 2004.

Harvey loved his family and worked hard to provide for them. He had numerous jobs and was a "jack of all trades". He loved to build and constructed three of the homes he lived in and helped in the building of multiple Kingdom Halls of Jehovah's Witnesses. In his early years, he worked for The Scranton Times then later owned a gas station and an auto parts store.

Harvey was known for many things including his great memory for details. He would captivate people with his stories and loved to make people laugh. He always claimed to be a descendent of "The Captain Morgan" however he was a descendent of the Morgan's from Wales, UK. He had a great singing voice (like his brothers) and loved singing on any occasion. Harvey also had a green thumb and loved working in his garden.

What Harvey was most admired for was his faith and love for his God, Jehovah. He was baptized as one of Jehovah's Witnesses in 1960. Although suffering from many different health issues, Harvey's faith and service to Jehovah never wavered. He enjoyed participation in his ministry where he preached early morning. Although Harvey was timid by nature, one would never know it. He loved sharing his stories and Bible truths to all different kinds of people. He firmly believed in and looked forward to the hope found at Revelation 21:3, 4 -"he will wipe out every tear from their eyes, and death will be no more, neither will mourning nor outcry nor pain be anymore. The former things have passed away."

He is survived by his wife, Helena, son Paul and his wife Vanda, daughter Donna Marks

and husband William, daughter Sandra McCoy and her husband Jarvis, and grandchildren, Christopher and wife Lauren, Carli Rooks and her husband Ken, and Tiffany Chandler and husband Austin, two great grandchildren and many nieces and nephews.
