August 20, 1935 - January 13, 2020

James “Jim” Richard Appleton (born August 20, 1935 in Springfield, Massachusetts) passed away on Monday, January 13, 2020 surrounded by his loved ones at the Gordon Hospice House in Statesville, North Carolina after 84 incredible years on this Earth.

He attended Cornell College and received his Medical Degree at the University of Maryland before pursuing a successful and meaningful career in otolaryngology and plastic surgery. After dedicating over 27 years to his civilian education, Jim served his country as a Captain and ENT surgeon during the Vietnam War.

He has joined his parents, Lloyd Otto Appleton and Linda (Spies) Appleton, in Heaven. He is survived by his beautiful wife of 61 years, Linda (Brown) Appleton; his sister, Dr. Judy Appleton; his two daughters, Martha Pallia and Rebecca Castillo; his son, Doug Appleton; fourteen beloved grandchildren; and six great-grandchildren.

He could talk to any person about any topic. He had an endless supply of entertaining stories from his lifetime and was always eager to share. He was personable and charming, with a belly laugh so contagious you couldn’t help but join in on the fun. He was candid and sincere – often the person relied upon to say what needed to be said. Above all, Jim was strong. Jim fought for greatness, respect, love, his country, his family; and he fought until the very end.

Jim’s brilliance, passion and benevolence will be remembered fondly by all those who had the great pleasure of knowing and loving him.
