William "Bill" Edward Morgan, 73, of Mooresville, passed away on Saturday, May 23rd, 2020, at Gordon Hospice House in Statesville.

Born November 22nd, 1946, in Greensboro, NC, he was a son of the late Rufus and Myrtle Roberts Morgan. Mr. Morgan was a graduate of Charles D.
