April 7, 1953 - January 19, 2016

Arthur Montgomery Hendrix Jr. M.D., 62, of Huntersville, NC died January 19, 2016. He was a native of Canton, Ga. and the son of the late Arthur Montgomery Hendrix Sr. and the late Selene Bloodworth Hendrix. He was a high school graduate of the Darlington School in Rome, Ga. He was a graduate of Duke University and he received his medical degree from the Medical College of Georgia in 1978. He did an internship in general surgery in Mobile, Al. and then began practicing emergency medicine in Athens, Ga. In 1981 he moved to NC to practice emergency medicine at Moore Regional Hospital in Pinehurst, NC. He moved to the Lake Norman area in 1988 and eventually joined the MEMA (Mid-Atlantic Emergency Medical Associates) family, where he continued practicing emergency medicine. Survivors include his wife Jeanne Howe Hendrix of Huntersville, NC. Two step children - Diana Metts of Aberdeen, NC and Michael Metts(Leigh Ann) of Cary, NC. Three sisters - Louise Forrester of Gainesville, Ga, Nancy Hendrix, MD and Martha Howell of Athens, Ga. One aunt - Rue Walker of Athens, Ga. Multiple nieces, nephews, and great nieces and nephews.
