Barbara Schneider Heilemann, 66, died October 2, 2105, at her home in Sherrills Ford, NC. She was born July 18, 1949, in Washington, DC to the late Dr. Frederick W. and Maria Mayr Schneider. Mrs. Heilemann was a high school Home Economics teacher at Park View High School in Sterling Park, VA before resigning in 1983 to accompany her husband, Richard, on an overseas civilian federal Government post for six years in Jeddah, Saudi Arabia. Upon their return to the US in 1989, they resided in Chantilly, VA where they stayed until their retirement from the US Geological Survey in Reston, VA in 2008.
