Betty Humble Dantzler, 90, of Mooresville, passed away on Wednesday, August 2, 2023 at the Summit Place at Mooresville.

She was born on March 1, 1933 in Asheboro, NC, to the late Ben and Virginia Dixon Humble. Mrs. Dantzler was a 1951 graduate of Asheboro High School, where she lettered in basketball. She received her bachelor's degree in education from Guilford College in 1955 and received her master's degree in special education from the University of South Florida in 1971.
