Brian Valentine Kelly, 84, of Mooresville, passed away on Tuesday, February 3, 2015 at the Alston Brook Nursing Home in Lexington.

He was born on June 17, 1930 in Oshkosh, WI, to the late Bernard Valentine and Leona Track Kelly. Mr. Kelly was a veteran serving in the US Navy. He was a Boy Scout, where he earned the award of Eagle Scout. Mr. Kelly received his Bachelor of Science in Secondary Education at Wisconsin State College, Bachelor of Business Administration at The University of Wisconsin, and his Master of Science in Physical Education from Indiana University. Mr. Kelly was a retired water safety instructor for the American Red Cross. He was a Past Grand knight of the Knights of Columbus and a member of the Y's Men's Club of Pacific Northwest Region and the YMCA, where he was a scuba instructor. Mr. Kelly was also a member of St. Therese Catholic Church in Mooresville.

In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by a sister, Monica Getchel.
