Bruno Raymond Dunn, 72, of Mooresville, NC peacefully passed away on Saturday, November 19, 2022.

Born in 1950 in Lewiston, Maine, Bruno was the oldest of three sons to the late John and Jenny Dunn. He was a wonderful husband and partner for 40 years and the loving father of three children.
