Bryan Robert Smith, 24, of Mooresville, passed away on Wednesday, March 14, 2018. He was born on August 5, 1993 in Rochester, NY, to Robert and Margaret Smith (née Wood). Bryan was a Cub Scout with Pack 47 at New Hope Lutheran Church in Kannapolis, Boy Scout with Troop 162 at St. Mark's Lutheran Church and Troop 180 at Fieldstone Presbyterian Church in Mooresville. Bryan served as Youth Delegate at the 194th North Carolina Episcopalian Diocesan Convention in 2010. Bryan was a member of the NCTSA. He served as a Junior Marshall 2010 and was a 2011 graduate of Mooresville High School, graduating with Academic Letter and National Honor Society. Bryan served as a communication intern with the Southern Oral History Program and managed offices and labs in the Communications and Linguistics Department at the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill. In 2015, he received a Bachelor's Degree in Linguistics as well as a Bachelor's Degree in Women's & Gender Studies from UNC Chapel Hill. At the University of Illinois at Champaign-Urbana he served as a coordinator within the Language Acquisition Lab in the Psychology Department. He was preceded in death by his maternal grandfather, Garnet J. Wood; and an uncle, Gregory Smith. In addition to his parents, he is survived by his brother, Alexander Smith; paternal grandparents, Richard and Joyce Smith; maternal grandmother, Donna Kauffman; and maternal step grandmother, Lynn Wood. A Memorial Service will be held at 4:00 PM on April 9, 2018 at St. Patrick's Episcopal Church, Mooresville. A reception will follow the service at St.
