Carlyle W. Nunn, Jr "Wilkie", 72, beloved husband, brother, father and grandfather died March 5, 2020 peacefully at home after a six-year battle with cancer. He was born November 25, 1947 in Goldsboro, NC to the late Janie Holland Nunn and Carlyle W. Nunn, Sr. After proudly serving in the U.S. Coast Guard aboard the Diligence during the Vietnam Era, he relocated to the Cabarrus and Iredell County area for the next 40 years.
