



## Chal Reid Sherrill

July 10, 1938 - April 16, 2021

Chal "Reid" Sherrill, 82, of Mooresville, passed away on Friday, April 16, 2021 at Atrium Health Carolinas Medical Center.

He was born on July 10, 1938 in Iredell County, NC, to the late Chal Lee Sherrill and Jean Mundy Sherrill. Mr. Sherrill was a veteran serving in the US Navy. He was a 1956 graduate of Mooresville High School and a 1965 graduate of Catawba College. Mr. Sherrill was retired from Ingersol-Rand in Davidson. He was a lifelong member of Central United Methodist Church in Mooresville. He was also a 50 year member of the Mooresville Lion's Club; where he served as president, secretary, and director. He was district cabinet secretary and treasurer for Lions Club District Governor Shaw Brown.

In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by his wife, June Irby Sherrill; sisters, Nancy Lee Hill, Juanita Killian, and Naomi Edwards; and brother, John Sherrill.
