Charleen Compton Cashion Lawson, a life-long Mooresville resident, passed away on May 12, 2018 at the age of 93 at Summit Place where she lived for the last 4 years of her life. Born on October 14, 1924 to the late William McKinley Compton and Macie Emma Lawson Compton, she was a 1941 graduate of Mooresville Central High School. Mrs. Lawson was employed by Duke Power Company and retired as office supervisor of the Mooresville office after 40 years of service. Mrs. Lawson was a lifelong member of Mooresville ARP Church where she served as deacon, Sunday school teacher, youth group leader, pianist for Wednesday evening services, and faithful choir member. She was active in the Women of the Church as well as serving on various committees over the years. She was also active in the community and worked as a tax aide volunteer for AARP for several years after her retirement. She lived a life of strong character, faith, integrity, generosity, and respect for others and was a wonderful example of a life well lived to her family and friends. Her church, family, and service to others were very important to her as was her love of music. We are grateful that Alzheimer's never dimmed her beautiful smile or took away her kind and gentle spirit.
