Charles Alexander McPherson, Jr., 93, of Mooresville, passed away on Wednesday, September 3, 2025, at the VA Medical Center Hospice Unit.

A proud veteran, Charlie dedicated 30 years of his life to the United States Army, achieving the rank of Chief Warrant Officer 4. His service included two tours in Vietnam, during which he was awarded the Purple Heart for his bravery. He played a unique role in history, assisting Elvis Presley in his transition to becoming a true Army veteran, ensuring that the King of Rock 'n' Roll found his footing in that significant chapter of life.
