



Dr. Chimanlal Popatlal Patel

November 5, 1927 - April 8, 2025

It is with deep sorrow that we announce the passing of Dr. Chimanlal Popatlal Patel, a cherished physician and devoted family man, who departed this life on April 8, 2025, at the age of 97. Dr. Patel's life was a celebration of dedication, compassion, and lifelong learning, impacting countless lives through his medical practice and personal relationships.

Born on November 5, 1927, in Borsad, Gujarat, India, Dr. Patel was the beloved son of Popatlal Fulabhai Patel, a distinguished lawyer, and Surajben Popatlal Patel. His upbringing in a family that valued education and professional excellence was the foundation for his illustrious career.

Dr. Patel's educational journey began at Edward Memorial High School in Borsad, followed by Maganlal Thakordas Balmukunddas College in Surat, where he studied Inter Science. He then pursued his passion for medicine at BJ Medical School, Gujarat University, in Ahmedabad, graduating with a Bachelor of Medicine, Bachelor of Surgery (MB;BS) on March 25, 1955. Committed to enhancing his practice, he earned a postgraduate diploma in acupuncture and stayed abreast of technological advancements through IT courses.

His professional journey began at the Salvation Army Emery Hospital in Anand, India, as a Resident House Physician. In 1955, he moved to Fort

Portal, Uganda, where he served as a General Independent Medical Practitioner until 1972. Dr. Patel's career continued in the United Kingdom, where he registered with the General Medical Council and practiced as a General Medical Practitioner in Upper Tulse Hill, London, until his retirement.

Dr. Patel's personal life was enriched by his marriage to Nirmala Umedbhai Vaghajibhai Patel on January 19, 1955. Their union, marked by love and partnership, lasted 63 years until Nirmala's passing in 2018. Together, they nurtured a family committed to education and professional excellence.

He is survived by his daughter Nilima Patel, a pharmacist, and her husband Dhimant Patel, along with their son, Dhinil Patel. His son Amrish Patel, a medical doctor, is married to Jyotika Patel, and they have three children: Jaisen, Dhru, and Raadha. His son Pragnesh Patel, an enterprise leader, is married to Sofia Patel, and they have two daughters, Linnea and Elina.

Dr. Patel was a global traveler, visiting numerous countries throughout his life, which broadened his perspective and enriched his experiences. His life was characterized by perseverance, dedication, and a profound commitment to his family and profession. His legacy of compassion and service continues through his children and grandchildren, who contribute to various fields and uphold the values he cherished.

Dr. Patel will be fondly remembered by his family, friends, and all who had the privilege of knowing him. His contributions to medicine and the lives he touched will forever be cherished. May he rest in peace.

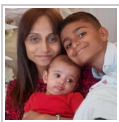
