



Clarence Randall McGlothlin

June 10, 1940 - January 10, 2024

Clarence Randall McGlothlin, passed away during the early evening of Wednesday, January 10, 2024, surrounded at home by his loved ones. Randall was born on June 10, 1940, in Raven, Virginia, to Clarence L. McGlothlin and Sybil Cyphers McGlothlin.

Randall, who loved to hunt and fish, wanted to be a forest ranger when he grew up.

Randall was also a member of the basketball and football teams for Richlands High School until he graduated in 1958. He then attended Bluefield College in Bluefield, VA for 2 years (1959-1960) and transferred to Virginia Polytechnic Institute (VPI) in Blacksburg, VA, where he earned the degree of Bachelor of Science in Business Accounting Major (1961-1962). Randall went to work for Ernst & Ernst after graduating from VPI and was employed there from 1962-1971 as a CPA in the Auditing Department. He also worked for Southland Rebuilders from 1971-1977 as an Assistant Manager. In 1977 Randall went to work for Hedrick Industries in Salisbury, NC, and continued there for over 30 years as Controller. He enjoyed his job, the people he worked with and the owners of the company. He retired in 2007 but continued as a part time consultant until 2015.

Randall was a loving husband and father, as well as a fun grandfather and great-grandfather, to whom he was known as "Caesar". He had an interesting personality, fun loving spirit, and was well-liked by all who knew him. His wisdom and humor will truly be missed.

In addition to his parents, Randall was preceded in death by his brother-in-law, Glenn Harris and great-grandson, Finley Kerr.

He is survived by his wife of 66 years, Vicki Harris McGlothlin; son, Randall Steven McGlothlin, and wife Lynn of Mooresville, NC; granddaughters, Ashley M. Kerr (Erik) of Fayetteville, GA, and Heather M. Watkins (Ryan) of Leicester, NC. Mr. McGlothlin is also survived by great-grandchildren, Pressley Kerr (14), Hayden Abee (13), Asher Kerr (12), and Madilyn Abee (10). He is survived by his sister, Jeanne Woods of Afton, OK, and brother-in-law, Clea Harris (Linda) of Richlands, VA, as well as nieces and nephews.
