Darryl (Pern) Lee Shope, 72, of Mooresville, passed away on Monday, February 12, 2024 at his residence after a long battle with cancer.

Darryl was born on August 6, 1951, in Haywood County, NC, to William Calvin and Genevieve Shope. He received a Bachelor of Science degree from Gardner Webb University in 1973. He wore many hats, including working as a supervisor for UPS, working for Nascar, and owning Foothills Medical Supply for the last 19 years.

He was an avid sports fan. He refereed high school football for many years. He sponsored multiple youth athletics and enjoyed cheering on Appalachian State University, as well as the North Carolina Tarheels. He was a member of Lake Forest Church in Huntersville.
