David Alexander “Alec” Ingle, 96, of Mooresville, passed away on Tuesday, November 5, 2019 at Genesis Healthcare in Mooresville.

He was born on March 12, 1923 in Alexander County, NC, to the late Carl and Oma Watt Ingle. David was a WWII veteran and a member of General George S. Patton’s 3rd Army and 90th Infantry Division. He served in conflict in France, Belgium, Luxembourg, and Germany as a machine gunner. He also fought in the relief at Bastogne and in the Ardennes Forest crossing the Siegfried line and received a Purple Heart. David worked in the CC Camp that helped to build the Blue Ridge Parkway. He spent the majority of his work career driving an 18 wheeler truck and retired from Public Transport.

In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by the mother of his son, Naomi Thompson Ingle; second wife, Pauline Harkey Ingle; and siblings, Panzie, Louvinie, Irenie, Geneva, Pauline, Ruby, Hazel, Virginia, Lee Roy, and Clifford.

He is survived by his son, Gary Ingle; granddaughter, Chris Ingle Mineroldi and husband, Mark; great granddaughter, Brinley Mineroldi; step granddaughter, Rhonda Walker; step great grandchildren, Shannon Carter, Anna Smith; and four step great great grandchildren.

The family will receive friends on Monday, November 11 from 10:00-11:00 AM with a service following at 11:00 AM at Fair View United Methodist Church in Mooresville. A graveside service with full military honors will be held at 11:00 AM on Wednesday, November 13 at Salisbury National Cemetery.
