Emory McLaurin, 70, of Mooresville, NC, passed away on Wednesday, February 14, 2024, at Iredell Memorial Hospital, Statesville.

He was born on February 20, 1953, in Surry County, to the late Lawrence Ernest McLaurin and Charlene Harwell McLaurin. In addition to his parents, he is preceded in death by a brother, Larry McLaurin.

He was the owner/operator of McLaurin Landscaping before his retirement. Emory served his community as a Police Officer for Mooresville Police Department and Davidson College Campus Police. He was working part-time at O'Riley's Auto Parts. He enjoyed going to car shows. He had a passion for old cars and trucks and really was big into Chevys.
