Denver Allen (D.A.) Hampton passed away peacefully at his home in Huntersville, NC June 16, 2023. Denver was born in Watauga County (Boone), NC April 11, 1941, to Darius Sebastian Hampton and Lena Carroll Hampton. Denver is preceded in death by his parents and his brother Wayne Houston Hampton.

Denver was a loving husband, father, brother, grandfather, and great grandfather.
