Earl B. Willis, Jr., 63, of Mooresville, passed away on Friday, June 2, 2017 at his home after a long and courageous battle against lung cancer.

Known as EB, he was born on January 28, 1954 to the late Earl Blanch and Rose McInturff Willis in Mooresville, NC. A lifetime resident of Mooresville, EB spent many years working in his called profession of funeral service. His work life ended in 2000 when he suffered major health issues that forced his early retirement. EB was a member of Allen Graham Masonic Lodge, York and Scottish Rite, Oasis Shrine and Cabarrus Shrine Club. He was a member of Oasis Patrol and a proud participant of the color guard. He is survived by his wife, Marla Sherrill Willis; son, Earl Chadwick Willis of Mooresville; daughter and son-in-law, Laura and Randy Bates of Burleson, TX. He also leaves behind the loves of his life, his grandchildren Addie, Braelyn, and Walker.
