Edward Joseph Hayes, Sr. 78, of Mooresville, NC, passed away on Thursday, April 1, 2021 at Gordon Hospice House with his family by his side.

Edward was born in Limerick City, Ireland on April 24, 1942 to the late Denis Hayes and Kathleen Hayes (Phillips). In addition to his parents, he is preceded in death by his wife, Rita Hayes (O'Halloran).
