August 13, 1953 - June 10, 2017

Edward Stephen Campbell, MD, 63, of Mooresville, passed away on Saturday, June 10, 2017 at his home in Sparta, NC. He was born on August 13, 1953 in Rockville Centre, NY to Dorothy Marie Fernbach Campbell, who survives, Johnson City, TN, and the late Edward Joseph Campbell. Dr. Campbell's beloved dog, Reecee, also preceded his death. Dr. Campbell graduated from Tusculum College, Greeneville, TN, in 1975, and served as Senior Class President. Dr. Campbell was a graduate of Bowman Gray School of Medicine, Wake Forest University, Class of 1981. He was a Navy scholarship student while in medical school. After graduation, he served in the Medical Corps, US Navy, from 1981- 1988, separating as a LCDR, Medical Corps. Dr. Campbell's life was dedicated to medicine, his family and the Lord Jesus. 1981-82, Dr. Campbell served his internship at the Naval Hospital in Jacksonville, FL; 1982-83, he served as one of five medical doctors for 5,000 men on the USS Independence CV-62; 1983-85, he completed his residency in Family Medicine at the Naval Hospital, Jacksonville, FL; 1985-86, he worked in the Emergency room at the Naval Hospital; 1986-88, he worked at the Aviation Family Practice Clinic and the Family Practice Clinic; September 1988-March 30, 2017, Dr. Campbell served the folks of the town of Mooresville, NC and surrounding areas, as a Family Physician, at Lake Norman Family Medicine. In the mid 1990's, the practice joined with Piedmont Health Care. Dr. Campbell is survived by his loving wife of 36 years, Marianne Spainhour Campbell; son, Michael Stephen Campbell & wife, Amber; daughter, Bethany

Anne Gatti and husband, Hunter, all of Mooresville; sister, Kathy Heagle and husband, Tim of Johnson City, TN; brothers, Don Campbell of Kingsport, TN, and Paul Campbell and wife, Julie of Alpharetta, GA; sister-in-law Nancy Spainhour and husband, Robert T. Thonen of Greenville, NC; grandchildren, Ada Grace and Abby Mae Campbell and Jade Elizabeth Gatti, all of Mooresville. His Aunt Freddie Fernbach, whose spouse was the late Dr. Donald Fernbach of Houston, TX; His Aunt L. Virginia Fernbach, survives in Springfield, VA. Ed leaves behind six nieces, two nephews and numerous cousins. Dr. Campbell was a self-taught woodworker and enjoyed making all sorts of projects and furniture. He loved the outdoors and enjoyed hiking, kayaking, and exploring the woods with his wife, Marianne, and granddaughters, Ada Grace and Abby Mae. He was an avid reader and stargazer and a friend to all. He will be sorely missed by many folks. A Celebration of Life will be held on Saturday, June 17 at 11:00 AM at The Cove Church with Rev. George Franco, Rev. Joel Stamper and Rev. Tim Stamper officiating. The family will greet family and friends immediately following the service in the atrium. Full military honors for Dr. Campbell will be held at 1:45 PM outside at the church. Campbell, M.D. - July 5, 2017 Posted: July 5, 2017 | Last Revised: July 5, 2017 Edward was my first nephew and my sisters' first born This is about his earlier years because it is the Edward, I knew best...And because I lived and worked near where my sister and brother-in-law lived on L.I., we spent many hours together reading, talking and exploring new and different adventures including his memorable trip to the NY Museum of Natural History at age 6 when he so impressed the Guard with the descriptions of the dinosaurs he had observed. His note and drawing to me shortly thereafter, when I left on an extended medical journey overseas was very touching... My mother and I gave him his very first books and I his last one of recent date. At age 10, I started him on a subscription to the National Geographic Magazine and sometime ago, I know he had every issue except one. I had more letters from him than anyone in the family and some years ago, I passed those along to him as I did others... Even as a teenager and in College, he reached out and we would talk and discuss matters. But then, Medical School, his naval career, marriage and a Family Practice came along and sadly our visits were fewer. To know Edward and the person and compassionate physician so many of you came to know and talked about at his Memorial Service, it might help to know about his strong and connected family ties his parents, maternal grandparents (in particular his grandmother); Aunt; Uncles and his special siblings. I remember so well taking him to visit his great-grandmother in a Nursing Home and he was not fearful but climbed up on her bed and much to her joy, hugged her. This was Edward from a very young age, a bright, caring and very gentle human being who even as a teenager when working as a life-guard thought nothing of reaching out and helping developmentally impaired fellow teenagers. So, his reaching out in later years did not surprise me. He followed in his maternal Uncles' path and attended Tusculum College in TN, that was known as a good pre-med school and then went on to become a physician as well. While he barely knew him due to living in another state, he was obviously inspired. He was inspired by a number of things in life- members of his family, other people, places and the natural environment in his all too-short

lifetime and among his many interests was his love of working with wood and his amazing artistry with it. I love my "Door Harp" and "Old Postal Truck" among other things. As so many of you attested to, he gave his all. With Love Aunt Ginny and till we meet again. I will post some old photos.
