Edwin Jones Cummings Stillman, Jr., 76, of Mooresville, passed away on Sunday, July 21, 2024 at Novant Health Presbyterian Hospital in Charlotte.

He was born on September 11, 1947 in Philadelphia, PA, to the late Edwin and Nellie Stalford Stillman. Mr. Stillman was a US Army veteran serving in the Vietnam War. He lived in the Pennsylvania area for 68 years before moving to Mooresville 8 years ago to be close to family. He had a very fulfilling career, as a tool and die maker.
