Eloise Boyd Young Aultman, passed away on Thursday, October 27, 2016 at the age of 93 in Davidson, North Carolina. Eloise was born in Due West, SC and was the daughter of Edwin Reynolds Young and Ivy Louise Boyd Young. She was preceded in death by her husband, Everett T. Aultman and sister, Eula Young Oates. Eloise is survived by her four sons – E. Taylor Aultman, Jr. and wife Susan (New Orleans); James Young Aultman and wife, Kathryn (San Antonio); Reynolds Young Aultman and wife, Jody (Ankeny, Iowa); and John N.
