Elvin "Ron" Fredrick Valentine, 85, of Statesville, passed away on Sunday, November 9, 2025 at his home surrounded by his loving family.

He was born on August 20, 1940, in West Palm Beach, Florida and raised in Alexandria, Virginia, where he sold newspapers from the age of 9-17. He was the son of the late William Earl Elvin Valentine and Frances Wright Windt.
