Lucille Thompson Deaton, 95, of Mooresville, passed away peacefully on Monday, March 31, 2025 at her residence.

She was born on March 26, 1930 in Mooresville, NC, to the late Eva Thompson Towell and RT Towell. Lucille was employed as office manager for Troutman Shirt Company for 32 years and continued working for Mooresville School System until the age of 70. She was a lifelong faithful member of Central United Methodist Church in Mooresville, where she served as a Sunday School teacher and was elected as the Methodist Women of the Year.
