Eunice Mae Dishman went home to be with her Lord and Savior on Thursday, June 12, 2014, after a brief stay in Winter Haven Hospital.

She was the daughter of the late Ansler Elze Dishman and late Lucy Isabell Nance Dishman.

Eunice was born July 14, 1937 in Mt Ulla, NC and grew up in the Mooresville area. She graduated from Troutman High School in 1955 and went on to Appalachian State Teachers College where she graduated with a degree in elementary education. She was the first in her family to graduate from college. She taught in the Mooresville City Schools for two years and then moved to Florida where she taught elementary school for almost 40 years. She was a loving daughter, sister, aunt and friend. She was an active member of First Presbyterian Church in Winter Haven, FL which she joined in 1981 and attended Centre Presbyterian Church in Mooresville when she came home to visit.
