Ev was a uniquely unique woman. She was the perfect combination of the quintessential southern lady and a true Steel Magnolia. She was a wife, mother, grandmother, great-grandmother, teacher and the epitome of a true friend to so many throughout her life. Ev's family meant everything to her, and she never wavered in their importance to her. She was born in Augusta, GA on September 21, 1931 and was the daughter of the late Harry Hilliard Thompson and Grace Pughsley Thompson. Ev grew up in the bucolic little southern town of Lyons, GA, and graduated from Wesleyan Conservatory with a B.A in Music and Music Education. After college, she married her cherished husband of 50 years, the late John "Jack" W. Tharp, and together they raised

their three girls in Charlotte, NC. Ev was an active member of her community especially when it came to children. She taught at Cotswold Elementary School for 34 years, and while she was known as being a bit strict, she was also beloved as a teacher who showed her students unconditional love and the unyielding belief in their abilities. In 1987, she was honored by the Charlotte- Mecklenburg Senior Center with the Distinguished Service Award as the city's outstanding senior worker, and upon her retirement she was honored by the Charlotte Observer as an educator of honor and high standards. In addition to her years of working with children, Ev was also an avid volunteer with the Mecklenburg County Board of Elections, and she took her role as a chief judge during election season with great pride and the utmost seriousness. Upon retirement, Ev and Jack moved to Davidson, NC in 1986. She was a member of Davidson College Presbyterian Church.

Ev was predeceased by her husband, Jack; and precious daughter, Nancy Tharp Walker.

She is survived by her daughters, Margaret Tharp Mueller (Greg), Frances Pauline Tharp, and special daughter, Fran Pughsley ("Squirt"); her beloved grandchildren, Gregory Mueller (Tel Aviv, Israel) and Evelyn "Evie" Walker McMahan (Ryan) of Mooresville, NC; her cherished great-grandsons, Walker and Thomas McMahan; and special great-grandsons, Bransen, Jack, and Braylen. She is also survived by her beloved sister, Barbara Meadows and many dear nieces, nephews and cousins.
