August 31, 1926 - March 14, 2021

Fay Nell Archie Ratledge, 94, of Mooresville, passed away on Sunday, March 14, 2021 at Summit Place of Mooresville.

Fay Nell, one of nine children, was born on August 31, 1926 in Iredell County, NC, to the late James and Ollie Mae Blackwelder Archie. She attended Mooresville Schools. After retiring in 1992 from General Time in Davidson, she volunteered at Lake Norman Regional Hospital from 1996 until 2016. During this period, she and her husband, Filmore, traveled frequently with Christian Tours traveling the United States. She loved to travel and to "visit" with family and friends. Since the mid 50's, Fay Nell was an active member of St. Mark's Lutheran Church in Mooresville.
