Mrs. Faye Brown Smith Peeler, age 91 of Mt. Ulla, died on Monday, October 9, 2023, at S. Mitchell Mack Hospice House in Mooresville.

Born September 20, 1932, to the late William Blenn Brown and Helen Karriker Brown. She was a 1950 graduate of Mt. Ulla High School and a graduate of Lowrance School of Nursing in Mooresville. Mrs. Peeler retired from the VA Hospital as an RN in Salisbury after 30 years of service. She was a life-long member of St. Lukes Lutheran Church of Mt.
