Floria Thomas, 83, of Mooresville, NC, passed away on Sunday, May 10, 2026 at The Atrium Hospice of Cabarrus County. Floria was born on August 2, 1942, in Lake Providence, LA. She was the daughter of the late John L. Taylor and Bettie Newell.

Floria loved spending time with family and friends. She graduated with honors from NC A & T University, with a Bachelor's Degree of Nursing, at the young age of 56. She was the oldest in her graduating class. She enjoyed discussing medical issues and had a wealth of knowledge in the medical field. Floria also liked watching medical shows on TV. If you were sick, she would encourage you to go to the doctor; however, if you mentioned your health condition to her, she would have you diagnosed before you even went to the doctor.

On May 31, 1969, she symbolized her dedication to Jehovah by complete water emersion and was baptized as one of Jehovah's Witnesses.
