Frances Sherrill Moore, 91, of Mooresville, passed away on Sunday, March 11, 2018 at the Brian Center of Mooresville. She was born on May 5, 1926 in Mooresville, NC, and was the daughter of the late Taylor Vinson and Fannie Brawley Sherrill. She was a graduate of Mooresville High School and Appalachian State Teachers College, now Appalachian State University. She majored in French and math and taught school for 35 years at Granite Falls High School, Troutman High School, Barium Springs Orphanage, and Shepherd Elementary School. She was also principal at Shepherd School for one year. She was baptized at Vanderburg United Methodist Church and was a lifelong member, having joined the church in 1935. She was very active in the church, singing in the choir, teaching in the children's department, and being a youth counselor. She also enjoyed keeping her Sunday School class decorated with seasonal flowers, until her health failed. In addition to her parents, she was preceded in death by her husband of 63 years, Harry Adolphus Moore in 2012; brothers, Horace Bell (Pete) Sherrill and Don Grey Sherrill; and a sister, Margaret Sherrill Allison. She is survived by her daughter and son-in-law, Kay and David Edmonds; sister-in-law, Natalyn Archer Sherrill; and numerous nieces, nephews, and cousins. The family will receive friends on Thursday, March 15 from 5:00-7:00 PM at Cavin-Cook Funeral Home.
