Mr. Francis “Frank” Luke Burke, 90, of Mooresville, passed away on Friday, February 15, 2019.

Born September 3, 1928, in Brooklyn, NY, he was a son of the late Luke Francis Burke and Cecilia Muller Burke. Mr. Burke moved to North Carolina from Queens, NY, in 1959. He opened the Draymore Manufacturing Plant in 1959, serving as plant manager. He then opened Troy Drapery in 1965 in Troy, NC, and retired after 37 years of service with Home Curtain Corporation. He was a member of St. Therese Catholic Church, Mooresville.

Mr. Burke was preceded in death by siblings, John Stephan, Marie Michel, Walter Stephan, William Stephan, Margaret Waugh and Mary Burke.

He is survived by a special nephew, George Insogna and wife, Marie; and many other nieces and nephews.
