Frank Wayne Karriker, 78, of Mooresville, passed away on Wednesday, November 30, 2016.

He was born on January 1, 1938 in Rowan County, to the late Garland and Effie Brawley Karriker. Frank was a veteran serving in the US Navy. He was a HAM Radio operator and communicated through Morse Code all over the world. Frank was licensed by the FCC and was known as a TV repairman in the 1970s in the Mooresville area. He retired from Cox Broadcasting/WSOC TV after 30 years of service as operations engineer. Later on in his life he read through the Bible and became an avid Bible analyst. He also repaired and collected antiques.

In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by sisters, Betty Rainwater, Barbara Cruise; and brothers, David and John Karriker.
