Fred Junior Jenkins, age 88, of Mooresville, NC, went to be with his Lord and Savior on Tuesday, July 16, 2024 at his home surrounded by his loving family.

He was born on August 21, 1935 in Taylorsville, NC, to the late Dock Solomon Watts and Fary May Wilson Watts.
