Garland Clyde Misener, Jr., passed away on Tuesday, July 24, 2018, in Sherrills Ford, North Carolina. He was 84.

Mr. Misener was born on December 26, 1933, in Ann Arbor, MI, to Garland Clyde Misener, Sr., and Erel Day Misener. He was a 1956 graduate of Colgate University of Hamilton, NY. He served in the United States Air Force as a 1st Lieutenant and Electronics Warfare Officer, and he and his B-52 flight crew won a commendation in the 1958 Air Force bomber navigation competition. He also served his country at the National Aeronautics and Space Administration (NASA) for 35 years, until his retirement in 1998.
