Harold Dean Henderson, 89, of Mooresville, passed away on December 8, 2025, at S. Mitchell Mack Hospice House, leaving behind a legacy of love and service. Born on August 20, 1936, in Asheville, NC, he was a beloved husband, father, grandfather, and friend, who touched the lives of all who knew him.

A devoted veteran, Harold served in the U.S. Army, stationed in Germany, reflecting his commitment to his country. After his military service, he dedicated 28 years to the U.S. Postal Service as a clerk, where his work ethic and sense of responsibility shone brightly.
