Hedrick "Bud" Miller Faggart, Jr., 86, of Mooresville, entered into his heavenly home on Easter Sunday, April 20, 2014 at his home surrounded by love.

Bud was born in Charlotte on June 3, 1927 to Hedrick Miller and Carrie Miller Faggart, who preceded him in death, as has sister Mary Ann (Faggart) Boesch.

He was a 1945 graduate of Charlotte's Old Central High School and served his country in the US Coast Guard stationed in the Atlantic.

Bud was married to his sweetheart Donna Foard Faggart for 51 years before her passing on June 16, 1999.

Mr. Faggart's business years involved mechanical contracting, culminating in the formation of his own company. He was a member of several related trade organizations.
