

## James Ray Beaty

October 15, 1936 - June 3, 2024

With heavy hearts, we announce the passing of James "Jim" Ray Beaty, who peacefully journeyed into eternal rest with his wife, Brenda, by his side, on Monday, June 3, 2024, in Charlotte, North Carolina, at the age of 87. Jim was born on October 15, 1936, in Charlotte, to the loving parents Calvin McCammie Beaty and Sara Emaline Stegall Beaty.

Jim was a man of remarkable accomplishments and dedication. A proud alumnus of Charlotte High School, he established Beaty's Bindery and Printing in his hometown in 1976, a venture he nurtured and ran with passion until his health began to wane.

Throughout his life, Jim was deeply involved in various fraternal orders, holding memberships in the Charles M. Setzer Masonic Lodge #693, Oasis Shriners, Provost Guard, and the Hillbilly Clan 13. In 1995, he served as Chief of the SASA Provost Guard. Additionally, he was an esteemed honorary member of the Oasis Patrol and Keystone KOPS. In 1995, he presided as President of the Mecklenburg Shrine Club. He also served on the Charlotte Court 109 ROJ. Jim proudly served in the US Army National Guard.

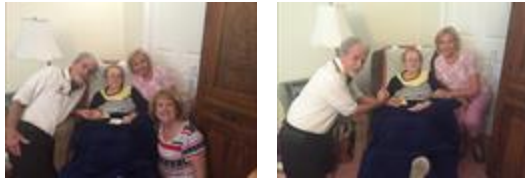
