James Clifton Armstrong, 85, of Mooresville, passed away on Thursday, November 26, 2015 at the Gordon Hospice House in Statesville.

He was born on January 7, 1930 in Iredell County, to the late Thomas Rowe Armstrong and Della Robinson Armstrong. Mr. Armstrong was a 1950 graduate of Brawley High School. He was a veteran serving in the US Marine Corps and a member of the Marine Corps League of Iredell County #1097.
