James Edward Levan, 91, of Salisbury, passed away on Tuesday, March 3, 2015 at The Laurels of Salisbury.

He was born on September 28, 1923 in Mooresville, to the late James Nelson and Ellen Ervin Levan. Mr. Levan was a WWII veteran serving in the US Army, where he was a part of the Signal Aviation Construction Company. He started playing the guitar at an early age and continued throughout his life. Mr. Levan was a member of First Baptist Church Mooresville, where he taught the young boy's Sunday School class for 14 years.

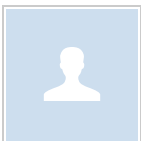
