James Ronald "Ronnie" Honeycutt, 73, of Mooresville, passed away on Tuesday, April 16, 2019, at his home surrounded by his loving family.

Born December 2, 1945, in Iredell County, he was a son of the late James Nelson and Lois Novella Oates Honeycutt. Mr. Honeycutt was a 1964 graduate of Troutman High School. He retired in 1999 as a Master Maintenance Mechanic for Duke Power Company-Plant Marshall. Mr. Honeycutt was a member of Fair View United Methodist Church, Mt.
