October 9, 1951 - March 14, 2021

Chief Petty Officer James Randall "Ike" Isenhower, retired, unexpectedly passed away in his home town of Mooresville, NC, at the age of 69. Randall was born to Georgia Reaba Hardesty and the late James Caleb Isehower on October 9th, 1951. Ike, as he was known by former coworkers and some friends, spent a majority of his career in the Navy as an Aeronautics Electrician. Randall, as he was known by family and hometown friends, was someone who knew how to have a good time.
