James Thomas "Tommy" Treadaway, 73, of Mooresville, passed away on Friday, October 9, 2015 surrounded by his loving family in his home.

He was born on January 14, 1942 in Iredell County, to the late James Wiley and Mattie Estelle McAlpine Treadaway. Tommy was a Project Manager for 20 years with Piedmont Bank/First Union in Davidson.
