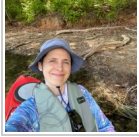

Sure, I said thank you and let her know I appreciated it very much, but I never told her just how hard I cried and just how deeply (like, soul deep!!), her generosity touched me.

Hindsight is 20/20 of course, and if I could go back in time and truly express to her just how much it meant, and how much she meant, I would happily do so every moment of every day. To know Jane was simply to love her. It was impossible not to. I'm going to miss her very, very much.
