Jean Houston Robinson, 90, of Mooresville, died on July 19, 2016 at Lower Cape Fear Hospice & Life Care Center in Whiteville, NC.

She was born on March 9, 1926 in Troutman, the daughter of Sherwood Harris Houston and Edna Spears Houston. Mrs. Robinson was a member of Broad Street United Methodist Church in Mooresville. She was a graduate of Troutman High School, where she was a member of the girls' basketball team. She was also the first female school bus driver in Iredell County. She worked for many years with Burlington Industries (Cascade Plant). She also worked for TG&Y and Ben Franklin Department Stores as an office secretary.

She was preceded in death in 2003 by her husband of 58 years, Kenneth Alexander Robinson; brothers, Herman Houston, Harry Houston, Thurston Houston and Glen Houston; sisters, Mildred Stutts, Annie Brawley, Rachel Mayhew, and Billie Sherrill.
