DAVIDSON – Jean Wilson Griffith, age 88, passed away on Sunday January 11, 2015 at the Pines of Davidson, Davidson, North Carolina. Jean, the daughter of John Wilson and Margaret MacDonald was born in Johnstown, Pennsylvania on October 6, 1926. She was married to Richard Owen Griffith, who was literally the boy next door, from June 1948 until Dick's death in 2005 and they raised two children: John David and Barbara Jean. Jean resided at various times in Johnstown, Pennsylvania, Caracas, Venezuela, Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania, and Hollidaysburg, Pennsylvania. She and Dick lived in Tenafly, New Jersey from 1973 until they retired to Davidson, North Carolina in 1991. Jean graduated from Dale High School in Johnstown in 1944 and then trained as a registered nurse under the auspices of the U.S. Army United States Cadet Corps, 1945-1947, at the Conemaugh Valley Memorial Hospital in Johnstown. In addition to working professionally as a nurse, Jean volunteered extensively throughout her life including the aftermath of the Johnstown flood of 1977. She is survived by her son John David Griffith (Charlene) of Rochester, New York, daughter Barbara Griffith Weiner (Gary) of Centennial, Colorado, her sister Barbara Ann Meyers (Charles) of Warner-Robbins, Georgia, her brother-in-law David Griffith (Marie) of Taos, New Mexico and

sister-in-law Phyllis Griffith, of Summersville, South Carolina. She is also survived by two grandchildren Sam David Weiner of Chicago, Illinois and Paul Owen Weiner of Centennial, Colorado.
