John C. Brauningger, 79, of Statesville, NC, passed away peacefully on Sunday, August 13, 2017, at Serenity House in Mooresville, NC. He was born in Cincinnati, Ohio on August 22, 1937, to the late Fred and Ethel Worley Brauningger. In addition to his parents, John is preceded in death by a son, John Scott Brauningger; daughter, Amy Brauningger Kallas and brother, Brian Brauningger. John graduated in 1955 from Reading High School in Reading, OH. He continued his education at the University of Cincinnati, graduating with a BBA Degree and his Officer Commission in the USAF in 1961. John was accepted as a teaching fellow at the University of Cincinnati and completed his MBA Degree in 1962, after a one year delay of entry into active duty to complete his MBA. John immediately went to active duty in 1962 and served as Base Procurement Officer for a SAC/8th Air Force base in Columbus, OH. He was honorably discharged in April 1965. John spent 14 years with a Fortune 500 company in northwest Ohio rising to the position of VP Marketing and Sales for the International Division. He became General Manager and owner for a recruiting franchise in Toledo, OH for about 12 years before relocating to the Mooresville, NC area to open his own recruiting firm. John left the recruiting business in 2002 after the 9/11 attacks and spent the remainder of his career in various real estate sales management positions. Left to cherish his memories and humorous side, is his partner and wife of 25 years, Elaine Burgin Brauningger; his caring sister, Jean Meyer and husband, Ed and their family of Cleves, OH; brother, F. Norbet Brauningger of Cincinnati,
