



## John 'Jack' David Wilson

April 7, 1928 - March 6, 2016

John David "Jack" Wilson, 87, formerly of Troy, OH, died of natural causes Sunday, March 6, 2016 in Mooresville, NC, where he had resided with his wife since 2015. He was born April 7, 1928 in Orange, NJ, to the late Clarence John and Helen Grundman Wilson. Jack graduated from the Morristown Prep School in Whippany, NJ, where he lettered in three sports and served as the captain of the football team. He earned a Bachelor of Arts in Marketing from Seton Hall University in South Orange, NJ. Jack served in the US Army during the Korean War. During his sales career, Jack and his family lived in Selinsgrove, PA, Shelton, CT, and Wickford, RI, before he retired from Hobart Corporation in Troy, OH. Later, he and his wife wintered in Marco Island, FL, where he enjoyed line dancing and card playing. A member of the Episcopal Church, Jack also belonged to Franklin Lodge 314 F&AM, in Troy, OH; Antioch Shrine Temple, in Dayton, OH; and American Legion, in Tipp City, OH. Jack was an avid sports fan, who especially enjoyed following Ohio State football and basketball. In addition to his parents, he is preceded in death by a brother, Donald Wilson. He is survived by his wife, Shirley Else Wilson; children, Nancy L. Wilson of Bratenahl, OH; Dr. James D. Wilson (Leslie) of Mooresville, NC, and Thomas J. Wilson (Vikki) of Hanover, MA; sisters, Helen "Happy" Ashley (Alan) of Verona, NJ, and Lois Weitz (Robert) of Jekyll Island, GA; grandchildren, Catherine Wilson, Rebecca Wilson, Allison Wilson, Jack Wilson and Perry Wilson.
